About the Seminar:

The Seminar boasted of speakers like **Manabi Bandhopadhya** who in becoming the Principal of Krishnanagar Women's College in 2015 created history and gave the struggle of the third gender a new dimension and position. She has written several books in the Bengali literature, and a biography, *A Gift of Goddess Lakshmi*, which was co-authored by Jhimli Mukherjee Pandey. She runs India's first transgender magazine, *Abomanob*. She spoke of her journey – a journey full of struggle, pain and humiliation, Dr. Bandhopadhya spoke of the need of educating the trans-people and that would empower them and help them claim their position in the society.

Prof. Rajarshi Mukerjee, **Department of History, Burdwan University**, specializes in the LGBTQ studies spoke of the history of the movement and how it developed in the country. Speaking of the legitimate rights of the third gender, Dr. Mukerjee spoke of the need to change the perspective of the society.

Minaskhi Sanyal, queer feminist activity and co-founder of Sappho for Equality, was the third speaker of the day. As an activist, she spoke of experiences of the third gender and how they can seek help and strengthen their self in the society.

Objectives of the seminar: The seminar was conducted with the intent of creating awareness about the third gender, to debunk myth about third gender and help the young students of the institution to also understand the rights and lives of the third gender.

The seminar received huge response and opened up new vistas of learning.

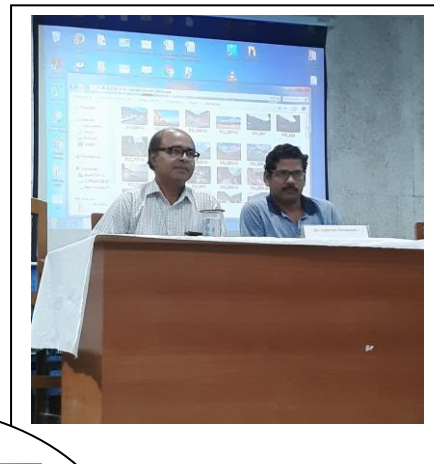

Report

The Challenges in Higher Education in the time of Covid and Beyond, the webinar was held on 21 June, 2020. The webinar conducted by Bhangar Mahavidyalaya in collaboration with Muralidhirdhar Girls College was one of the first webinars in Bengal on the said topic. In the early months of the pandemic, the way one had been looking at education scenario was undergoing a sea-change. It was a challenge both for the teachers and students in higher education specially with the suddenness it was ushered into our lives.

With Prof Shamantak Das, Department of Comparative Literature of Jadavpur University and IQAC Director, Jadavpur University speaking on the topic extensively pointing out the need for accepting digital education and that the modules taught to students need to be framed in a manner that could compensate class room teaching. He further discussed the challenges in the NPE 2020 Education policies and how institutes of Higher Education must be equipped and prepared for the future.

Around 87 participants including faculties of both the organizing institutes and other colleges of Bengal and students participated in the webinar. The male, female ratio was 5:4.

The question-and-answer session had faculties who expressed their eagerness to find more ways and solution to face the situation, a sense of preparedness as pointed out by the speaker of session, ended this very interesting and learning session.
