

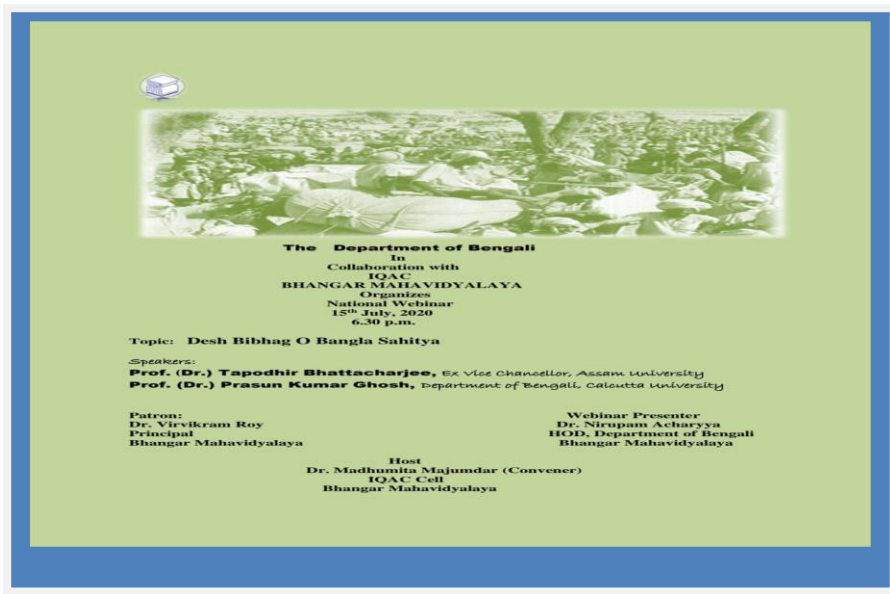

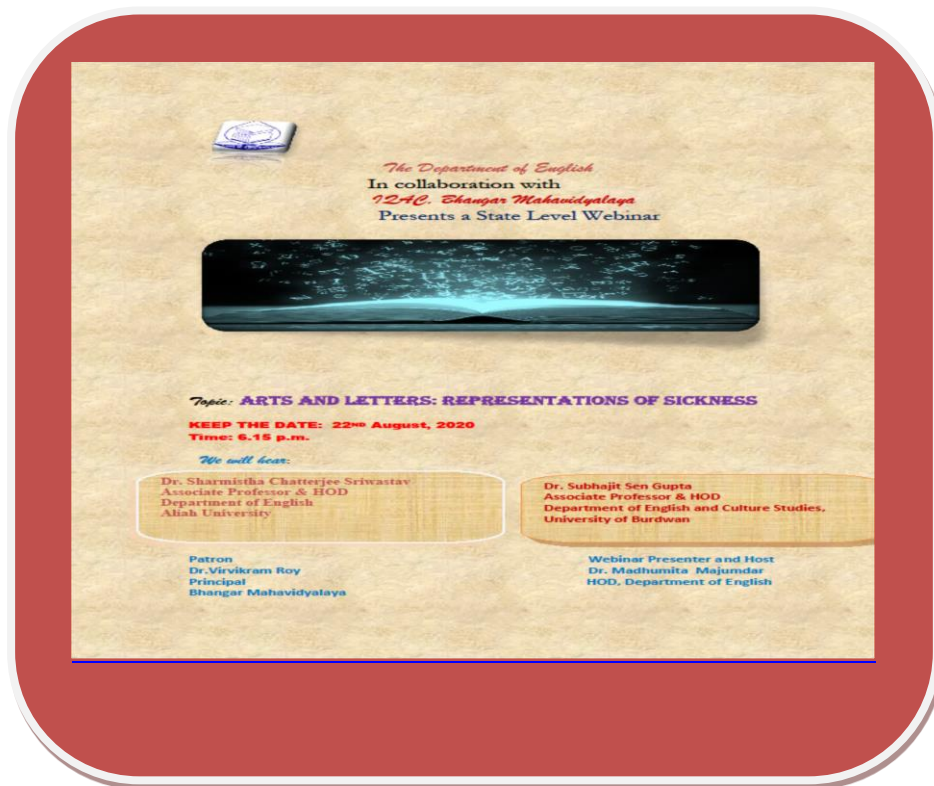

Report on the State Level Webinar of Arabic Department
