**Webinar Objectives**: to teach the students about M.N. Roy's Concept of Radical Democracy political thought and to explain his philosophy of Radical Humanism



**Seminar Objectives**: to make students aware of the important of the Arabic language and the prospects and the opportunities available inside and outside India.





## **REPORT:**

Arabic is a very old and viable language. Millions of people use it in their day to day life. In the past it has preserved a vast knowledge of the world e.g. Indian, Greek, Persian etc. from ruination and decay and contributed to various fields of science and literature such as prose, poetry, medicine, mathematics, optics, astronomy and so on and so forth. it reached to its zenith during the Abbasside period and achieved the status of Langua Franca. It lost its glory because of unrest in Spain and Mongol and Turkish invasion from East and went through a relative stagnation. Its revival begun when Napoleon Bonaparte invaded Egypt in 1879 A.D. and now it has became world most attractive language than other in view of providing better opportunity of work and life style after discovery of oil in Arab world

In spite of all that there are some misconception among the students that Arabic is world toughest language and its acquisition is almost impossible. Unfortunately these misconceptions are hindering Arabic teaching and learning process and making us ineffective in our strategies. Today we will discuss how to remove such misconceptions
